SUBJECT: North Carolina Principal Fellows Program Application for 2017 – 2019 (Class 24)

The application process is now open for the 2017 - 2019 North Carolina Principal Fellows Program scholarship loan.

There are several things you should keep in mind as you complete and submit the application:

- A. This is a competitive, merit-based process. While meeting the nine minimum criteria makes you eligible to be <u>considered</u> for a scholarship loan, it does not mean you will be selected to receive a scholarship loan. Exceptions are not made for applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifying criteria.
- B. The deadline for submission of the application is Friday, February 3, 2017. You must complete the online application by midnight on this date. <u>All required documents including references must also be uploaded or received by this date</u>. Failure to submit all required documents by the deadline may result in your application not being reviewed for eligibility.
- C. The \$45.00 application fee is non-refundable, non-deductible and non-applicable to tuition or any fees.
- **D.** You must have applied to a Master of School Administration program at a participating institution and must have been **<u>unconditionally</u>** admitted to the program by the time the Principal Fellows Commission selects the recipients in spring 2017.
- E. As an applicant, it is important that you make your school district/employer aware of your application for a scholarship loan. Section C, should be used to discuss with the appropriate officials the two year leave of absence which you must take if awarded a Principal Fellows scholarship loan. If selected as a Principal Fellow, you will need to apply for an official leave of absence or resign your position. Note: continuation of the state health plan for the Fellow is ONLY available to Fellows who are on an official leave of absence from their school system.
- **F.** Please use the <u>checklist</u> below, to ensure that you are uploading all required items and retain the checklist for your records. Do not upload the checklist as a part of the packet.
